Last July, Thea* (*name changed for privacy*) reached out to New City, seeking a new place for her two children to attend school. A recent divorce had brought upheaval into Thea's family. Her youngest son was overwhelmed in a typical public school classroom where he seemed to be labeled rather than cultivated. Aware that he was performing below his classmates, her son shut down, crying every morning when Thea dropped him off at school.

In August, both of Thea's children started school at New City. Within weeks, Thea shared that her son suddenly had an interest in school again. He woke up wanting to come to school and was excited to read words on cereal boxes during breakfast. Thea's daughter, already a high performing student, surpassed all expectations as her inquisitive nature and academic skills blossomed in New City's environment.

As her children's first year at New City comes to a close, Thea shared these thoughts:

"Your school has literally transformed our entire family. Your love, guidance and support have given my precious babies peace and happiness. There are no words to describe what you mean to us! New City has been the gateway for my children to become the people that God created them to be."

New City exists to serve families like Thea's. Our mission is to equip our students with knowledge, confidence and hope, and we are grateful to see signs that this is happening. For the first time in the school's history, 100% of our 3rd through 5th graders tested as reading at or above their grade levels, compared to their peers nationally.
