Ledgewood Ministry

For 25 years Trinity has had a relationship with the families in the Ledgewood Community in Oakley. Trinity has a Kids Club on Tuesday afternoons for the children living at Ledgewood. We bring them to Trinity for a Bible lesson, snack and activities. Our desire is for the families at Ledgewood to be a part of our Trinity family.

In order to encourage the families to attend Trinity, Gary Cort will take the church van to Ledgewood on Sunday mornings and bring families and/or children to Trinity for Sunday School and the 11:00 Worship Service. To give a warm welcome to the families and children, we are planning a “Buddy System”. We are asking that adults and older teens volunteer to meet the van at the church doors at 9:50.

There will be no “assigning” of families to a particular person or family. We will probably not know who is coming until they get on the van! We are praying that this will lead to building relationships and that attendance will become regular. The “Buddies” would see that the families and children get to their appropriate Sunday School classes and then pick them up from Sunday School and sit with them during the late service. Gary will meet the families after the late service and take them back to Ledgewood.
