The Church 1 Peter 3:8-22 (NASB) | *The Beautiful Life* Chad Smith

To sum up, all of you be harmonious, sympathetic, brotherly, kindhearted, and humble in spirit;⁹ not returning evil for evil or insult for insult, but giving a blessing instead; for you were called for the very purpose that you might inherit a blessing.¹⁰ For,

“THE ONE WHO DESIRES LIFE, TO LOVE AND SEE GOOD DAYS,
MUST KEEP HIS TONGUE FROM EVIL AND HIS LIPS FROM SPEAKING DECEIT.
¹¹ “HE MUST TURN AWAY FROM EVIL AND DO GOOD;
HE MUST SEEK PEACE AND PURSUE IT.
¹² “FOR THE EYES OF THE LORD ARE TOWARD THE RIGHTEOUS,
AND HIS EARS ATTEND TO THEIR PRAYER,
BUT THE FACE OF THE LORD IS AGAINST THOSE WHO DO EVIL.”

¹³ Who is there to harm you if you prove zealous for what is good? ¹⁴ But even if you should suffer for the sake of righteousness, you are blessed. AND DO NOT FEAR THEIR INTIMIDATION, AND DO NOT BE TROUBLED, ¹⁵ but sanctify Christ as Lord in your hearts, always *being* ready to make a defense to everyone who asks you to give an account for the hope that is in you, yet with gentleness and reverence; ¹⁶ and keep a good conscience so that in the thing in which you are slandered, those who revile your good behavior in Christ will be put to shame. ¹⁷ For it is better, if God should will it so, that you suffer for doing what is right rather than for doing what is wrong. ¹⁸ For Christ also died for sins once for all, *the* just for *the* unjust, so that He might bring us to God, having been put to death in the flesh, but made alive in the spirit; ¹⁹ in which also He went and made proclamation to the spirits *now* in prison, ²⁰ who once were disobedient, when the patience of God kept waiting in the days of Noah, during the construction of the ark, in which a few, that is, eight persons, were brought safely through *the* water. ²¹ Corresponding to that, baptism now saves you—not the removal of dirt from the flesh, but an appeal to God for a good conscience—through the resurrection of Jesus Christ, ²² who is at the right hand of God, having gone into heaven, after angels and authorities and powers had been subjected to Him.

MISSION FOCUS

Asheville Area Habitat for Humanity Homeownership Program

"If I hadn't found Habitat, we would still be in that one-bedroom apartment. And it wasn't the best of conditions.

"For almost a year, I was working seven days a week, plus doing sweat equity. Depending on my shifts, I would work a morning shift, then go to the Habitat ReStore and work an evening shift there. Monday through Friday, I took Habitat classes in the evening, and put in my construction hours on the weekends – every Saturday possible.

"While constructing the house, I got to know my neighbors. We built each other's homes, and you can't get much closer than that. The biggest difference overall is that general sense of security. Just knowing that it's ours and we make all the decisions – it's been really comforting for our family."

Asheville Area Habitat builds simple, affordable, energy-efficient 2, 3 and 4-bedroom houses that are sold to qualifying buyers who repay a 30-year mortgage (serviced by Habitat). Applicants must qualify based on Residency Status, Need, Ability to Pay, and Willingness to Partner (see below for details).

Qualifications for Homeownership

Following are the basic Homeowner Selection Criteria for Asheville Area Habitat for Humanity. More details are covered in the Information Sessions.

Residency Status

- Must have lived and/or worked in Buncombe County for a minimum of 12 months prior to application.
- Applicants must be legal U.S. residents.

Need

- Living in overcrowded housing or substandard housing.
- Paying more than 30% of gross income on rent.
- Living in temporary, subsidized, or public housing.

Ability to Pay

- **Income:** Income must be stable and fall below 70% of Housing and Urban Development's (HUD) Area Median Income.
- **Delinquent Debt:** No more than \$1,500 in total balances at the time of application.
- **Medical Collections less than three years old:** No more than \$2,500.
- **Revolving Debt (ie: credit card debt):** No more than \$2,500 in total balances at the time of application, excluding student loan or automobile loan debt.
- **Bankruptcy:** Must wait two years after being discharged.

Willingness to Partner

- Each applicant who will be listed on the deed must be willing to perform 200 hours of *Sweat Equity*.
- Applicants must be willing to complete a Homebuyer Education program.
- Appropriate accommodations can be made for families with physical limitations in accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).
