## GOD SPEAKS TO US

### Sermon

Matthew 20:29-21:11

*The Children's King*

Chad Smith

<sup>29</sup>As they were leaving Jericho, a large crowd followed Him. <sup>30</sup>And two blind men sitting by the road, hearing that Jesus was passing by, cried out, "Lord, have mercy on us, Son of David!" <sup>31</sup>The crowd sternly told them to be quiet, but they cried out all the more, "Lord, Son of David, have mercy on us!" <sup>32</sup>And Jesus stopped and called them, and said, "What do you want Me to do for you?" <sup>33</sup>They said to Him, "Lord, *we want* our eyes to be opened." <sup>34</sup>Moved with compassion, Jesus touched their eyes; and immediately they regained their sight and followed Him.

<sup>21:1</sup>When they had approached Jerusalem and had come to Bethphage, at the Mount of Olives, then Jesus sent two disciples, <sup>2</sup>saying to them, "Go into the village opposite you, and immediately you will find a donkey tied *there* and a colt with her; untie them and bring them to Me. <sup>3</sup>If anyone says anything to you, you shall say, 'The Lord has need of them,' and immediately he will send them." <sup>4</sup>This took place to fulfill what was spoken through the prophet:

<sup>5</sup>"SAY TO THE DAUGHTER OF ZION, 'BEHOLD YOUR KING IS COMING TO YOU, GENTLE, AND MOUNTED ON A DONKEY, EVEN ON A COLT, THE FOAL OF A BEAST OF BURDEN.'"

<sup>6</sup>The disciples went and did just as Jesus had instructed them, <sup>7</sup>and brought the donkey and the colt, and laid their coats on them; and He sat on the coats. <sup>8</sup>Most of the crowd spread their coats in the road, and others were cutting branches from the trees and spreading them in the road. <sup>9</sup>The crowds going ahead of Him, and those who followed, were shouting,

"Hosanna to the Son of David;  
BLESSED IS HE WHO COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD;  
Hosanna in the highest!"

<sup>10</sup>When He had entered Jerusalem, all the city was stirred, saying, "Who is this?" <sup>11</sup>And the crowds were saying, "This is the prophet Jesus, from Nazareth in Galilee."


