Understanding the Gospel

John 3:16 tells us: "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life."

This passage answers basic questions of who, what, why, when, and how. Please ask any of our church leaders to talk with you about what the Bible says about lesus.

- God so loved the world...
 - God loved the world in such a way to rescue people from their sins against Him (John 3:17; Il Corinthians 5:21).
- · He gave His only begotten Son...
 - He sent His Son to live among us, to show us His love, and to pay the penalty for our sins through His death on the cross (Romans 5:8; 6:23).
- That whoever believes in Him...
 - Believing in Christ means trusting in Him as the One who fully paid for our sins, and turning from our sins (including trusting in ourselves). It means receiving His free gift of salvation and full forgiveness, and trusting His Lordship in our lives (John 1:12; Ephesians 2:8-10; I John 5:11,12).
- · Shall not perish, but have everlasting life.

Through faith in Jesus, we have eternal life and a family relationship with God as our Father. Because we trust Jesus as the One who died for our sins, we are rescued from God's judgment and have new life in His name (John 5:24; John 10:10; John 11:25,26).

There is one gospel on which I stand for all eternity.

It is my story, my Father's plan, the Son has rescued me.

Oh, what a gospel, oh what a peace. My highest joy and my deepest need.

Now and forever, he is my light. I stand in the gospel of Jesus Christ.

There is one gospel to which I cling, all else I count as loss.

For there, where justice and mercy meet, he saved me on the cross.

No more I boast in what I can bring, no more I carry the weight of sin.

For he has brought me from death to life. I stand in the gospel of Jesus Christ.

MISSION FOCUS

David and Danielle Grotton | MTW Chile

We told you about wildfires that affected our city in February of this year, destroying anywhere between 8,000 and 16,000 homes (depending on the source). Sadly, 135 people lost their lives. Since February, our team has been actively involved in meeting physical and spiritual needs. Because of your generosity with gifts to the CEMIPRE Project, we have purchased and distributed: clothing, mattresses, food, and construction materials.

In March, we received an MTW Disaster Assessment Team who helped us to prioritize the needs and set goals. Since their assessment, we have begun to receive construction teams from the U.S.

Are you skilled in carpentry, plumbing, and electrical work and are available to help repair and rebuild homes destroyed by wildfires here in Viña del Mar? We need you! Dates are flexible. Approximate cost is \$1,000 plus airfare to Santiago, Chile. Get in touch with any questions: https://mtw.org/opportunity-details/chile-disaster-response-teams.

Gospel Fellowship PCA (Valencia, PA) sent a team of four individuals highly-skilled in carpentry, plumbing, and electrical work. Only four days after they arrived, Claudia (a widow) and her family have a safe, dry place to call "home". In addition, their team has purchased and distributed food, bedding, and construction materials for other families with the funds from their church and from the Compassion Fund. Please continue to give! We will keep building and distributing supplies!

A second construction team arrives on April 14. Pray for continued safety and for God to be glorified in their work. Give thanks to God for all the ways that we see Him at work.

David is excited to begin to mentor A.M., a university student, meeting regularly to discuss the Bible and how to live it in our daily lives. Pray for David (language, wisdom, and trust in the Lord).

The regular cycle of in-home Bible studies has resumed with a study of the gospel of Mark. We have the privilege of hosting a group in our home, with the extra blessing of having lots of children! Pray for visitors and seekers to experience God's peace and to know His love personally.

After a pause in March to assist with wildfire relief, we welcomed an almost entirely new group of CEMIPRE participants this year. May they grow in knowledge, abilities, and in relationship with the Lord. Pray for our staff to be patient and quick to forgive one another...
